- **EIE** (European Implementation Event) in Newcastle, United Kingdom.

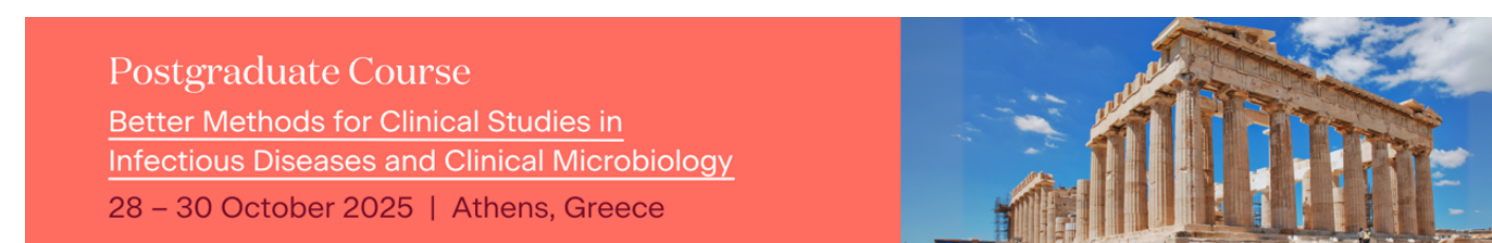
