Late October, members of the REVERSE team presented at the National Conference of Infectious Diseases in Sibiu, Romania!

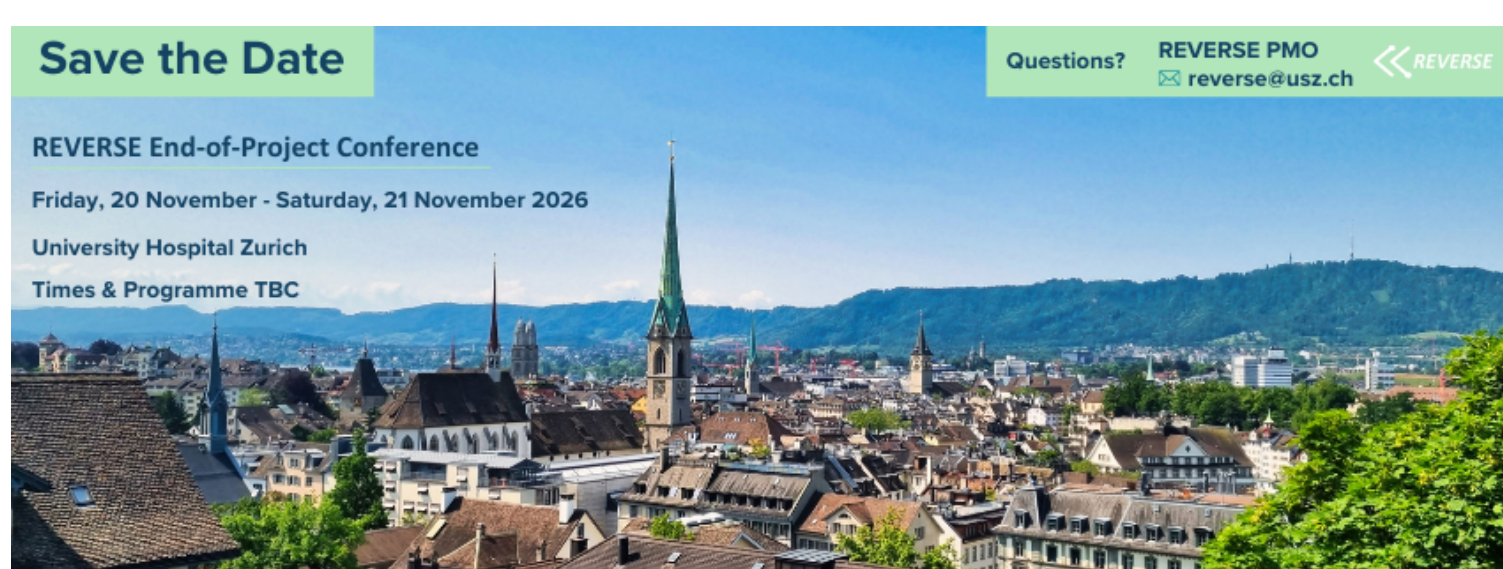
